The infrastructure of the Vienna Stock Exchange

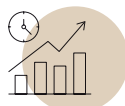

Centralised securities depository is essential for the functioning of capital markets.

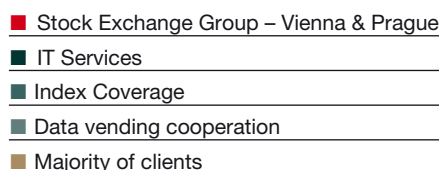
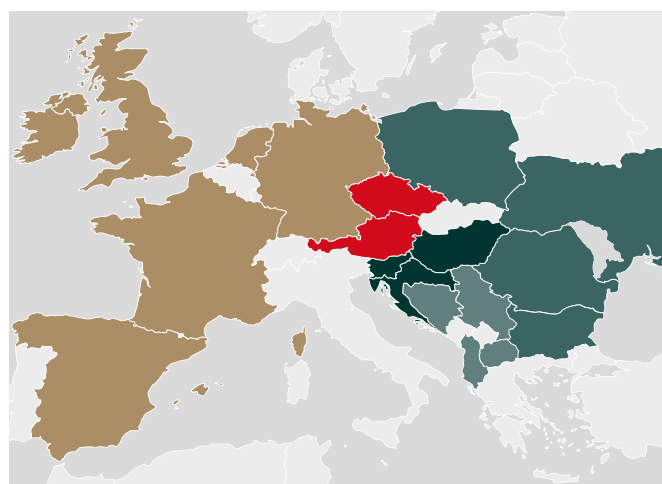
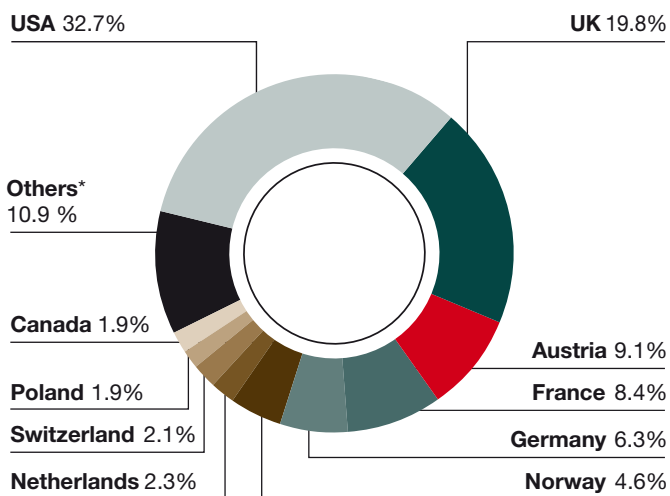
Internationality of the Vienna Stock Exchange
